1. Chug's

- **Location:** Coconut Grove
- **Other standout menu item:** Cuban sandwich empanadas

At Chug's in Coconut Grove, chef/owner Michael Beltran's [Cuban sandwich](#) is cheesy, crunchy and bursting with flavor. Made with sourdough, honey ham and black pepper salami, think of Beltran's version as a more gourmet version compared to [Miami's](#) otherwise traditional varieties. And get this: If you're in the mood for a twist, take it up a notch with the Cuban sandwich empanadas, filled with mojo duck, Swiss cheese, ham, mustard aioli and butter pickles.
